PLANNING YOUR GIVING

We recommend you seek advice from a solicitor when making your Will. The information presented here is not legal advice.

- 1. Decide to make a gift to RMC in your Will
- 2. Choose the type of gift you would like to make:
 - A specific sum of money
 - A percentage of your estate
 - A percentage of the rest of your estate after making other gifts
- **3.** Ask your solicitor to include the gift in your Will

HOW TO GIVE

Your solicitor may find it useful to refer to this wording when completing your Will.

I give [\$XXX] [x% of my estate] [the whole of my estate] to Robert Menzies College (ABN 68 089 369 013) for its general purposes. I direct that the receipt of the secretary or treasurer or other proper officer of Robert Menzies College will be a sufficient discharge to my Trustee. ⁶⁶ I have enjoyed every aspect of RMC. Most of all, I have met some of the most amazing people in the world. RMC has been just like home, only your family is huge. "

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Why should I leave a gift to Robert Menzies College?

Your gift is the most effective means of guaranteeing the future of Robert Menzies College (RMC). Student fees allow the College to run. However, generous gifts from our community and alumni provide scholarships, help fund building programs and upgrade facilities. It was the kindness of our supporters that helped RMC continue to nurture and empower students through crises like the COVID-19 pandemic.

I can't give much—is it still worth considering a gift in my Will to Robert Menzies College?

Yes! We are extremely grateful for all gifts, large or small. Your generosity will have a lasting, positive impact in the lives of students, no matter how much you give.

What is the best way to make a gift, if I already have a Will?

If you already have a Will, adding a gift to the College is simple. Your solicitor just needs to redo your Will with the new gift added or to prepare a codicil – a short document adding the gift.



Is it possible to leave a gift for a specific purpose?

Yes. You can target your bequest toward a specific purpose such as a scholarship fund, building program or something else. Please speak to our office about your wishes, so we can make sure your gift can be effective as possible in the long term.

Is there a minimum amount for establishing a scholarship in perpetuity?

Yes, there is, but that's something we'd need to discuss with you. Please contact our office for a confidential conversation.

Do I need to notify Robert Menzies College if I leave a gift to it?

While it's not essential, we do encourage you to let us know so that we can thank you and keep you up to date with our College programs and any relevant information.
