RMC Campus Ministry Scholarship

The goal of this scholarship is to promote and enable RMC residents' involvement in ministry and outreach within the Macquarie University community *beyond* RMC.

The scholarship recipient will be an individual with gifts and passion to serve in Christian ministry with and to students within the broader Macquarie University community.

The scholarship provides for up to 50% of the value of an ABCD room.

The scholarship is open to current or prospective residents of RMC.

Criteria:

In awarding these scholarships attention is given to the following criteria:

- Outstanding Christian character, spiritual and personal maturity, eagerness and passion for Christian ministry.
- Commitment to community involvement, service, and extra-curricular activities
- Leadership qualities or leadership potential demonstrated through active involvement in student organisations at Macquarie University
- Potential to contribute to the life of the College in the future
- Demonstrated financial need

Responsibilities:

Say and show the gospel of reconciliation with God through the death & resurrection of Jesus Christ on the campus of Macquarie University through:

- Participating in the life of the RMC community
- Being actively involved in a Christian campus ministry organization
- Participating at Trinity Chapel Macquarie or Macquarie Indonesian Trinity Chapel
- Mobilising Christian residents at RMC to be involved in ministry to the campus
- Using RMC's facilities & resources as a place of hospitality focused on Christian mission to students of Macquarie University

Opportunities:

- The recipient is encouraged to study one or more Theology units at an accredited theological college if this fits with their study program at Macquarie University
- Mentoring with a member of the Chaplaincy team
